the Children Worldwide" program.

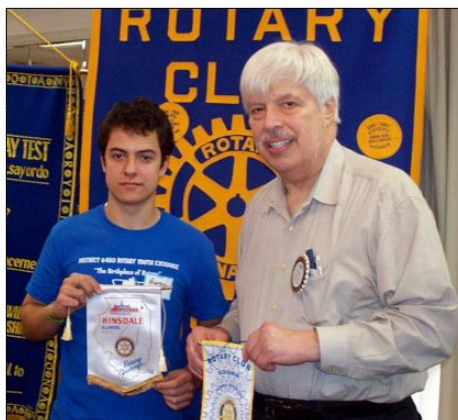
**April 10th-** "Around The World with
