## Rotary/Cubs strike out polio...

Joshua Kim, age 14 decided last summer to donate all his allowance to Rotary's End Polio Now campaign. A year later he would be taking the mound for the ceremonial first pitch at Strike Out Polio: Rotary Day at Wrigley Field.

"I've always wanted to do this," said Joshua, whose father, Tony, is a member of the Rotary Club of Chicagoland Korean-Northbrook. His dad was in the stands with more than 600 Chicago-area Rotarians, relatives, & friends. Rotary Day at Wrigley brought in more than \$10,000 for polio eradication. The Cubs contributed \$20 for each ticket sold by Rotary clubs. An End Polio Now message appeared on Wrigley Field's famous marquee, with announcement made inside the ballpark before and during the game.
