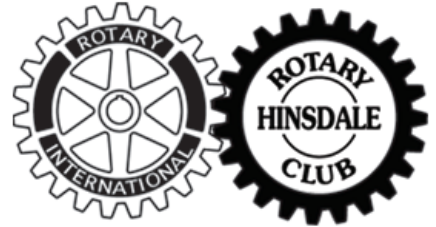

They're Fun, They're Educational, They're New Rotary Programs!!!...

In an effort to make our Friday meetings more enjoyable, and to encourage our members to invite more guests, Program Chair **Chuck Snyder** has arranged some new and interesting programs for this year. Today's program, titled "From Heavy Metal to Beethoven--Using X-rays in Environmental Science", will be presented by local Argonne Labs', Ken Kemner. Ken obtained his PhD in Condensed Matter Physics at the University of Notre Dame in 1993. He was awarded the Graduate Student Teacher of the Year at the University of Notre Dame in 1988. From 1993 to 1996 he was a National Research Council Post-Doctoral Fellow at the Naval Research Laboratory where he focused on the investigation of magnetic materials and environmental research. In 1996 he joined the Environmental Research Division at Argonne, where he began to develop and is still developing the Molecular Environmental Science Research Group, an integrated multidisciplinary scientific research group interested in making use of third generation synchrotron radiation for environmental research. In 1999 he received the Presidential Early Career Scientist Award and the DOE-Office of Science Early Career Scientist Award. In 2000 he received the International Union of Crystallography Young Scientist Award.

Since 2003 he has been an adjunct professor in the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at the University of Notre Dame. Since 1997, he has been investigating mineral-microbe-metal interactions and their use in environmental cleanup strategies.
